
STUDY OF JESUS

(FROM THE GOSPEL OF JOHN)

OBJECTIVE:

1. The purpose of this study is to produce faith in Jesus (John 20:30-31).
2. At least these verses should be covered.
3. This material should be covered in one or more studies.
4. Each one studying should read the assigned chapters for homework and come back ready to share questions raised and what was learned.
5. Key questions in each chapter:
 - What did Jesus say?
 - What do you think he meant?
 - How does it apply to your life?

KEY VERSES:

1:1-5,14 God became flesh in the form of Jesus.

3:1-7 We must be born again of water and Spirit to enter the kingdom.

3:16-18 Without belief in Jesus, one is condemned.

4:16-19 Jesus was not afraid to expose people's sins.

5:22-23,27 We will be judged by Jesus because he became a man and lived a sinless life. God demands that we honor Him.

5:30,44 Jesus' priority was to please God, not Himself. Ours should be the same.

6:60-69 Will we turn away because of hard teaching or not understanding? If we are convinced Jesus is the only way to eternal life we will never turn away.

8:31-32 Disciples must hold to Jesus' teaching.

14:6 Jesus is the only way to God.

14:15 If we love Jesus, we will obey Him by following the Bible.

15:18-21 Persecution is inevitable.

20:29-31 Do you believe that Jesus is the Son of God and that God raised Him from the dead

1 Jn 2:4-6 What do you think God expects from you?

Challenge Over the next few days/weeks, we will study about the life of Jesus – who Jesus is and what He expects from us. Will you take this challenge?

OPTIONAL VERSES:

1:12-13 Belief does not make us children of God; it only gives us the right to become children of God.

2:1-11 First miracle. The disciples put their faith in Him.

2:12-17 Clearing the temple. He had strong convictions.

4:1-2 They were constantly baptizing disciples.

4:21-24 We must know the one we are worshiping. We must worship in spirit and truth. It does matter to God how we worship.

4:34-42 Jesus' food was making disciples.

6:5-14 Jesus feeds 5,000.

6:16-21 Jesus walks on water!

8:1-11 Woman caught in adultery.

11:38-48 Jesus raised a man from the dead.

12:24-26 One must be willing to die to self to be used by God.

15:2,8,16 God expects every Christian to bear fruit.

17:23 Jesus prayed for our unity for a reason - to reach the world with the gospel.

18:1-19:42 Jesus' death and burial.
